



FINANCIAL INCLUSION COORDINATOR

Christians Together in Fleet & Church Crookham is looking to appoint a Financial Inclusion Coordinator to work as part of Hart Foodbank.

As well as providing emergency food parcels, Hart Foodbank is expanding the services it offers its clients to include:

- Active signposting to the following support services, who will be working very closely with Hart Foodbank in 2023 :-
 - Income Maximisation through Benefit advice, via Citizens Advice (CA).
 - Debt Management through debt management and relief advice (CA and Christians Against Poverty (CAP).
 - Life Skills Training (CAP)
 - Money Management
 - Nutrition education & Cooking skills
- A Community Food Pantry (located in Hook, Fleet and Darby Green)
- Additional signposting to other yet-to-be-agreed services.

The Financial Inclusion Coordinator will lead a team of volunteers, working together to understand a Foodbank Client's wider needs for support and to journey with them in ensuring that they meet with, and successfully engage with specialists who can provide the help that they need.

We are looking for someone with leadership and organisational skills who can lead and manage volunteers across this wider remit. So, if you:

- > Have a passion for serving the most vulnerable in our local community
- > Have experience of leading volunteers
- > Can engage with local authorities and other stakeholder organisations.
- > Can demonstrate experience of similar or related work, paid or unpaid.

Salary of £14,100 (£23.500 FTE) for 22.5 hours work a week, initially on a 12 month fixed term contract, but with an expectation to extend to 3 yrs.
